2. Facilities for students:

The following facilities are available at this faculty centre:

1) Class Rooms – Besides usual class rooms, the specialized class rooms are equipped with computer, internet facilities and LCD (Liquid Crystal Display) projector for conducting classes through power point presentation.

2) Laboratories- Well equipped different laboratories are provided for the students like Soil Testing laboratory for analyzing macro & micro plant nutrients, Microbiology laboratory, Mushroom laboratory, Quality Control & Molecular Biology Laboratory, *Trichoderma* (Bio-fungicide) laboratory *etc.* *Trichoderma* laboratory is equipped with the facilities of bio-pesticide preparation and culture for eco-friendly-control bio-agents. Students use these laboratories with the guidance of the experts and laboratory assistant for soil testing, microbial culture preparation, bio-fertilizer preparation, *Trichoderma* preparation, quality parameters testing of different experimental farm products *etc.*

3) Rural Information Centre (RIC)-

A separate room namely RIC workshop is provided for making specimens, models, charts, posters *etc.* related to rural development works as well as displaying of different activities through pictorial forms.

4) Library – IRTDM faculty established a library with about 24000 sq ft floor area comprising of general and individual reading sections, e-library, journal and newspaper sections, book stake section coupled with an office for the librarian.

5) Computer Laboratory- A well-furnished big computer lab accommodating 43 computers with internet connectivity & a LCD projector to facilitate basic computer course for students. This lab is available throughout the day for learning practices, preparation of seminar, assignments, power point, project work, dissertation and other educational related works.

6) Seminar Hall- An air conditioned seminar hall with seating capacity of 150 persons supplemented with modern electronic gadgets, broad band connectivity for conducting seminars, classes through video-conferencing *etc.*

7) Broad Band Connectivity-

Broadband internet connectivity helps the students to get easy access to vast amounts of academic information, besides helping them to get the benefit of tele-education. Some classes are being conducted at IRTDM Faculty Centre, Ranchi by experts stationed at Belur Math.

8) Conference Room- There is a large conference room along with computer, internet and LCD projector facilities. The room is essentially used for conducting Academic Council & Board of Studies meetings, monthly staff meetings as well as for seminar presentation.

9) Examination Hall- A separate examination hall with 100 seating capacity is dedicated for students to provide a peaceful examination atmosphere throughout the year.

10) Class Room Study Facilities-

Students are provided with class room study facility within the premises beyond class hours and holidays also, which is found to be very much beneficial for concentrative study.

3. Sports and Games facilities:

The faculty centre provides both indoor and outdoor sports facilities. The students are encouraged to play outdoor games like badminton, volley ball and cricket. The students during the recess period enhance their sporting skills playing Table Tennis and Carom Board.

4. Hostel facilities:

This faculty centre does not have hostel facilities of its own but a few students with extremely poor economic background and those representing tribal communities are provided with residential facility in farmers' hostel at our *Divyayan Krishi Vigyan Kendra*.

5. Other facilities:

The staff and their family members are covered under the medical insurance facility.

6. Any other information:

Uniqueness:

- a) Inclusion of students in the teaching-learning process.
- b) Formation of different student groups to develop the leadership skill and corporate skill among the students.
- c) Experiments are carried out to standardize the organic farming procedures mentioned in our scriptures.
- d) Participatory exercises are carried out in a village as a method of community empowerment and learning procedure.
- e) Successfully inculcated 'learning through action' habit among the students that created a win-win situation for the villagers and students.

Special features:

1. **Title** – Formation of different student groups to facilitate extra-scholastic activities of the faculty centre.
2. **Objectives** – To develop the leadership skill and inculcate the sense of responsibility among the student.
3. **Context** – The master mind in education strongly believe today that education should not be restricted in the periphery of classroom teaching singularly. Contrarily, it should expand itself and put into practice.
4. **Practice** – Organising special lecture, to make campus clean and green, organizing cultural programmes, management and operation of ICT resources, publication of magazines, management of experimental plots etc.
5. **Evidence of success** – Frequency of special lecture has been increased significantly after the formation of Student excellence team, faculty centre successfully publishing e-magazine and wall magazine, faculty campus is now a no plastic zone, experimental plots are now diligently managed by the students without any farm labour, IRTDM faculty became the pioneer in initiating online admission in the RKMVU.

Placement:

All students of final semester were selected as 'Consultant Agriculture' under CFT through campus selection conducted by Jharkhand State Livelihood Promotion Society, under department of Rural Development, Government of Jharkhand.

Since the inception of this course all students have been successfully placed in different reputed organisations.
